Child care:

Child care is available on demand and financed by the Ministry for Family, Women, Culture, and Integration.

Scope of the courses:

One course consists of six modules, each with fifty 45-minute lessons; it therefore encompasses a total of 300 lessons.

Participation:

Participation in the course is voluntary and free-of-charge.



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Content of the courses:

The courses are based on the "Initial orientation and learning German for asylum seekers" concept. The contents include the following topics:

Every-day life in Germany with the topics

- Work
- Shopping
- Health & Health care
- Kindergarten & School
- Media usage in Germany
- Finding one's way around
- Transport and mobility
- Habits and customs in Germany
- Local particularities
- · Speaking about oneself and others
- Social contacts
- Housing
- Values and living together

In addition to the lessons, the participants go on excursions, for example to local authorities, the library or the market. These excursions help participants to better find their way around locally and to apply what they have learned in practice.
